



VERIFICATION STATEMENT GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

Bureau Veritas North America, Inc. (BVNA) was engaged to conduct an independent verification of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reported by Colgate-Palmolive (Colgate) for the period stated below. This Verification Statement applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

The determination of the GHG emissions is the sole responsibility of Colgate. BVNA's sole responsibility was to provide independent verification on the accuracy of the GHG emissions reported, and on the underlying systems and processes used to collect, analyze and review the information.

Boundaries of the reporting company GHG emissions covered by the verification:

- Financial Control
- Worldwide

Emissions data verified: Scope 3

- **Category 2 - Capital Goods (Land, Land Improvements, Buildings, Machinery and Equipment):** 134,000 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Category 3 - Fuel- and Energy-Related Activities Not Included in Scope 1 or Scope 2:** 129,000 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Category 4 - Upstream Transportation and Distribution:** 436,000 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Category 5 - Waste Generated in Operations:** 60,000 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Category 6 - Business Travel:** 44,000 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Category 7 - Employee Commuting:** 75,000 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Category 8 - Upstream Leased Assets:** 85,000 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent

Data and information supporting the Scope 3 GHG emissions assertion were in some cases estimated rather than historical in nature.

Period covered by GHG emissions verification:

- January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018

- World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3)

- ISO 14064-3: Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the validation and verification of greenhouse gas assertions

Level of Assurance and Qualifications:

- This verification used a materiality threshold of $\pm 5\%$ for aggregate errors in sampled data for each of the above indicators

GHG Verification Methodology:

- Interviews with relevant personnel of Colgate including external contractors at the corporate level;
- Review of documentary evidence produced by Colgate;
- Review of Colgate data and information systems and methodology for collection, aggregation, analysis and review of information used to determine GHG emissions; and
- Audit of sample of data used by Colgate to determine GHG emissions.

Assurance Opinion:

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the GHG emissions assertion shown above:

- is not a fair representation of the GHG emissions data and information; and
- has not been prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard.

It is our opinion that Colgate has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation and analysis of quantitative data for determination of these GHG emissions for the stated period and boundaries.
